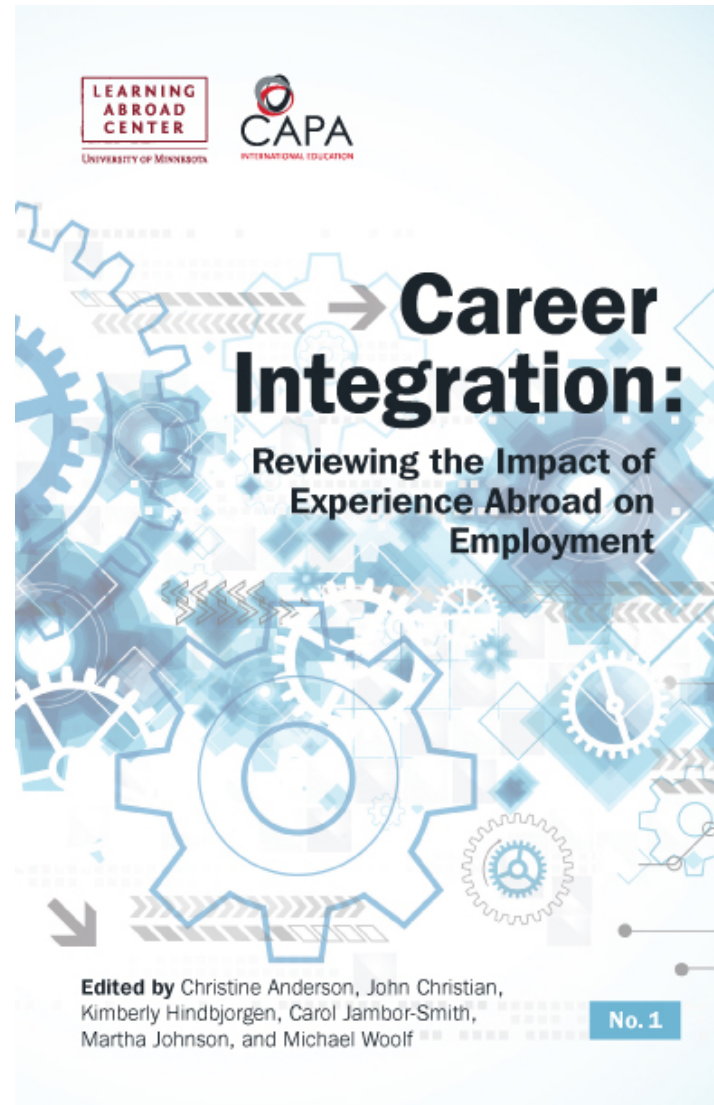

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# Publication Schedule

Call for Papers announcement –August 15, 2018

Paper submissions due – November 1, 2018

Editorial board meets to review submissions – December 2018

Contributors notified - January 2019

Author returns edited draft – February 2019

Publisher completes design and layout of work – March 2019

Work is printed – April 2019

Ready to handout at NAFSA – May 2019

# Advice for Contributors and Style Guide

- Prospective papers should be between 1000 and 4000 words (2-8 pages) maximum
- MLA Style Guide
- Visuals difficult to reproduce
