

LONDON SAMPLE INTERNSHIP LIST FINANCE

INDUSTRY DESCRIPTION

Finance internships are very highly sought after in London and as such, many corporate firms have established graduate recruitment schemes. However, CEA CAPA has continued to build relationships with organisations and departments that provide excellent opportunities for students seeking to develop their skills in the finance industry. Students should have strong analytical skills and a good attention to detail and should be able to demonstrate relevant academic modules or coursework. It is also advantageous to highlight previous extra-curricular activities or vocational experiences related to this industry. It should be noted that placements in banks, investment firms, asset, and wealth management agencies are unavailable for short term placements. Finance interns should have realistic expectations on the type of organisation they will be placed in, which will generally be small-medium and not 'top-4' firms. Interns with limited financial experience, may be re-directed to consider accountancy, if applicable.
